## Dear Parent/Carer

We hope you've all had a great time over the half term. The children have settled in quickly and are looking forward to their learning. We hope you find the following information useful.

## **Class Trips**

Unfortunately, we were unable to secure a suitable date for the Jodrell Bank trip last term however a specialist pottery workshop was arranged for the children instead, which they enjoyed very much, to support their learning about Ancient Greece. You should already have received a letter for the Whitehall Outdoor Activity day in July. Due to the cost of this trip being so high we have decided not to go to Styal Mill in the Summer Term as well because it is also an expensive trip. We have however booked a Victorian experience day in School on the 5<sup>th</sup> June. An actor works with the children using lots of different artifacts and activities. We're sure it will be great fun and it is at a much reduced cost (probably about £3 per child).

#### Homework

Spellings are handed out weekly on Wednesday, to be tested on the following Wednesday. English homework, will be handed out on Friday to be collected in on the following Thursday, Maths workbooks are marked with the children every Monday. The aim of our homework activities is generally to consolidate work learned in class and keep skills sharp, also to help you be aware of the kinds of things we are working on in school. Each piece of homework should take no longer than 30 minutes to complete. If your child finds the homework difficult, please let us know by writing a note in their homework book. Please come and see me if you are unsure what your child needs to do. In addition, please encourage your child to read several times through the week. Fluent readers could read alone and then be asked questions about the text.

PE is on Thursday and Monday afternoon, lessons are provided by a sports coach. For children to participate in these lessons they must have indoor and outdoor PE kit in school.
